Quick-start themes for student interest-based groups

STEM & Innovation

- Robotics Rookies – Build and program simple robots to complete challenges.
- STEM Builders – Design bridges, towers, and Rube Goldberg machines.
- Tech Explorers – Learn basic coding, app design, or video game creation.

Arts & Expression

- Young Authors' Workshop – Write and publish stories, poetry, or a class anthology.
- Drama Stars – Script, rehearse, and perform short plays or skits.
- Visual Arts Studio – Explore painting, sculpture, or digital art projects.

Leadership & Communication

- Debate & Speech Team – Practice persuasive speaking and host a mini-debate.
- School News Crew – Create podcasts, video reports, or a student newspaper.
- Young Entrepreneurs – Design, market, and “sell” products at a school marketplace.

Exploration & Service

- Environmental Explorers – Investigate ecosystems and create a school sustainability campaign.
- History Detectives – Research local history and share findings through exhibits or digital timelines.
- Community Helpers – Plan service projects (e.g., kindness campaign, donation drive).

Tip: Start with 3–4 options per cycle based on **staff expertise** and **student survey results**. Rotate each semester to keep offerings fresh.
